DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This L-shaped two story shingle house is at 100 Archer Street in the Town of Bel Air, Harford County, Maryland. It has a slate gable roof. Its two bay ell projects to the front at the north. The windows are 1/1 double-hung sash in molded surrounds. A side porch to the south in the angle of the ell has been enclosed. A central chimney with a corbelled cap rises in the ridge of the ell.

What makes this house different is the hood over the front door (in the south bay of the ell); it is altogether unprecedented on Archer Street. It may be a later addition but need not be. A narrow single pane transom tops the door.

## STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This little L-shaped house is unusual for Archer Street. Both its floor plan and its door hood make it different. It was built on land Francis H. Iglehart bought from the Bel Air Land Company in 1907 (122/46). He paid \$450 for two large lots back to back on Thomas Street. In 1920 he owned the store and house at the corner of Main Street and Lee next to the Armory. The 1920 tax assessment makes no mention of the Hays Addition property. Surely this house was built before 1920. It is remarkably countrified to have been built even in 1907, but there cannot have been anything on those lots or they would have brought more than \$450.

The Hays Addition was land in the estate of merchant Thomas Hays who died in 1861.





