## DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Diana's Thrift Shop is a 2-1/2 story duplex house with a brick exterior and one-story porch, dating from the early 20th century and located on the east side of Churchville Road (MD 22) opposite the intersection of Snake and Grafton Lanes.

The house may be frame with a brick veneer. The main elevation has four bays with entrances originally in the tow inner bays. The southeastern section now serves as the thrift shop and the door has been shifted to allow for two display windows flanking it. The shed roofed porch has simple scroll sawn brackets. The windows are 6/6 except in the shop section. A dormer with paired windows is centered in the hip roof. An interior chimney rises behind the peak of the roof.


