DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Scarborough House is a 2½ story frame house with a one story porch which was built in about 1910 and is located at the end of a driveway on the north side of Churchville Road (MD 22) about ½ mile west of the intersection of Churchville Road and Priest Ford Road (MD 136).

The house is located on the ridge dividing the Bush River and Deer Creek watersheds at the end of a long "allee" or driveway with flanking trees. The location provides a scenic view toward the northwest. The main elevation faces south toward the driveway across a circular drive. The gable roofed main section has three irregular bays and a shed dormer with double interior chimneys. The entrance is off-center and is flanked by a single window on the left and two windows on the right. The second floor has paired windows in the center bay with single windows in the outer bays. The shed dormer has three windows. All windows except the dormer have green louvred shutters. The one-story porch extends across three elevations and is supported by plain "Tuscan" columns.

The exterior is white clapboards and the roof is slate. The sides of the dormer are also covered in slate.

The rear elevation has an ell wing and other additions. A frame barn and some other small outbuildings are located north of the house, but were not fully observed.


