DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Colgate Nursery consists of a late 19th century or early 20th century farmhouse with several mid-20th century outbuildings located to the rear of the main house. The complex is at the end of a dirt driveway on the south side of Churchville Road (MD 22) across from the Campus Hills Shopping Center.

The house is a two-story frame house with a center gable peak on the main elevation. The main section has been greatly altered by 20th century additions and changes, but the general outline of a typical 3-bay farmhouse is still visible. The exterior is asbestos shingles and the roof is modern composition material.

Further observation and photography were not permitted by the nursery employee present at the time of survey. However, the owners were not contacted and may be willing to give permission for further evaluation.
