Rogers Street - two story framw house, three bays wide by the equivalent of three bays deep, rockfaced formstone foundation, gable and roof longitudinally oriented, 1/1 sash windows, wrap-around porch on East (street) has a bay window and Doric columns, gabled swellfront on South, gabled dormer on North, transome over door.

This house believed to have been built in the early 1890's. (All six houses on Rogers St., both sides of the street, built then, including the Harvey house torn down to make way for the Equitable Trust Drive-in.

Builders of this home, Dr. Kriete, lived at 15 S. Rogers St. in rented rooms while building their home at 16 S. Rogers St.
