The Mathis House faces south on the north side of Route 144, just east of the Alvin G. Leamon House, H0-200.

It is a three bay wide, one room deep, two story high, gabled roof (running east-west) frame (covered with aluminum siding) structure with square brick chimneys inset into its east and west walls and central intersecting gable on its south elevation holding a four light bull's eye.

A two story high, two bay wide, one room deep intersecting gable roof (running north-south) log kitchen wing extends north from the west side of the building's north wall. Its enclosed staircase east of the square brick chimney centered into its north wall indicates a possible earlier construction date than the front section of the house, which features cross paneled central south entrance flanked by five vertical lights and surmounted by a three light transom. A one story high, hipped roof, open porch runs along this entire elevation, which is partially enclosed on the west.

Owned by Donald Mathis and family, it was once owned by John W. Buckingham as noted in the 1878 Hopkins Atlas of Lisbon.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Mathis House, H0-201 faces south on the north side of Route 144.

It is a three bay wide, one room deep, two story high, gabled roof (running east-west) frame (covered with white aluminum siding) house, resting on a stone foundation with brick chimneys inset into its east and west walls. A central intersecting attic gable holds a four light bulls'eye on the south elevation, which features a central rectangular, cross paneled entrance door, flanked by five vertical side lights and surmounted by three light transom. Single floor to ceiling five-five light french doors rest on each side of the central entrance with three second floor, rectangular, four-over-four light, double-hung windows resting above. A one story high, semi-enclosed, hipped roof porch runs almost entirely along this elevation. Two cement steps lead to this porch.

The west elevation of the house holds two double-hung, six-over-six light, rectangular first floor windows and one four-over-four light, rectangular, double-hung second floor window. The east elevation holds two four light attic casement windows, a second floor, four-over-four light, double-hung window and a central exterior brick chimney. A cellar door is located north of the chimney.

Lying off the west side of the building's north wall is a two story high, two bay wide, one room deep, intersecting gable roof (running north-south) log kitchen wing with square brick chimney inset into its north wall, which may antedate the front section of the house. No apertures appear on this north wall, on which is constructed a shed roofed, one story high enclosed addition, which holds only a two light casement window on its east wall. The log kitchen holds an east entrance in its south bay and a rectangular, six-over-six light window in its north bay. Two six light casement windows rest above. The west elevation holds two six-over-six light, rectangular, double-hung windows, vertically aligned to second floor windows above.

A one story high, shed roofed enclosed vestibule runs along the remainder of the north elevation of the front section of the house. It holds a rectangular north entrance, flanked by a single six light window.

The interior of the Log Kitchen wing features a one way staircase with rectangular, batten wood entrance on its north wall east of the chimney.

The front section of the house features log joists in the dirt floor basement which is set into a rock foundation. A central hall features a staircase with square spindles and original knewel post, while the east and west rooms feature two outstanding wooden mantlepieces. That in the east room is decorated with a English perpendicular arch with keystone.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Mathis House is architecturally and historically significant to the village of Lisbon.

Architecturally it is an interesting example of a three bay wide, one room deep, two story high gabled roof (running east-west) frame house, featuring a fine central entrance, flanked by five vertical side lights, surmounted by a three light transom and brick chimneys inset into its east and west walls.

The interior of the house features a central hall staircase, holding simple square spindles with original knewel post. The east room of the front section of the house features an exceptionally fine perpendicular wooden mantle piece, decorated with Keystone. It is similar to one found in HO-105, the Ellicott House on Route 94 and in the Bernard Warfield House, HO-113 on the south east corner of Route 94 and Mullinex Road.

The log kitchen wing, probably was constructed after the front, though there is a belief that it antedate the front section of the house. This is due to the smaller scale of this section, as well as to the enclosed staircase located east of the square brick chimney, located on the north wall of the kitchen. By 1860 the house had been constructed in its present form (see Attachment 3) and again in 1878 was clearly delineated on the Hopkins Atlas Map of Lisbon, attachment 4 as belonging to John W. Buckingham. It is presently owned by Mr. and Mrs. Donald Mathis and previously by Charles Mathis, father of the present owner.

Its importance to the streetscape along the north side of Route 144 cannot be over emphasized. It, along with its neighbor to the west, H-200 creates a very important anchor on this north east corner of Routes 94 and 144. This is particularly true after the demolition of the old buildings once located on this corner and their replacement by a modern brick house.

Important architecturally and historically to Lisbon, Howard County and the State of Maryland, this building, along with the entire village of Lisbon, should be placed on the National Register of Historic Places and the State Critical Areas Program.

HO 201 is a two storey frame dwelling with a present exterior treatment of red asphalt shingles.

Three bays in length at the S. elevation, the center door is framed by over and side lights and is flanked by a single floor-to-ceiling casement window to each side.

The roof plan is A frame with a single centered cross gable at the south elevation. At each end of the roof ridge is a single interior gable chimney.

at the facade (S. elevation) is a single storey Victorian porch with Victorian Gothic turrets at the eaves.


