### DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a frame farmhouse of unusual style. Unlike most local structures, it features a four-bay, main (east) facade, and the bays are unevenly paired to each side of the central door. A later, one-story screen porch spans the front of the house. On the north end is a large, external chimney that has a fireplace base on the first floor only. The chimney has been covered with stucco. A sloping, shed-roof addition covers the (west) rear of the house. Windows are 6/6.

Ezekiel Moxley House (Rte. 124, Woodfield, Md.)

Spring, 1976

Mrs. (Moyer) Bowman of Takoma Park called. Said she grew up in this house. It was indeed an old Moxley place. The oldest part is the rear shed-roof part. It is built of logs and had stove-type chimney flues. The front is later and is frame. The old log portion has a slate roof (now covered) and was the first house in the area to have a slate roof. Log part had 4 rooms, 2 up and 2 down, kitchen and dining room down. The Moyers moved into it-April of 1917. Sold in 1936 or '37. The really old log house-possibly a slave quarters-sat to the rear of this house-it had large chimney fireplaces, and was in an abandoned, ruinous condition in the early 1900's-gone now. Her father tore down the old log house or slave quarters. There were also 2 old log outbuildings-ice house, etc., that are gone now. Her father helped move and build the old store on Old Georgetown Rd. in Bethesda-across from N.I.H. about 1921 or '22.-A Will Lewis builder? Her husband's family-the Bowmans-owned several large mills in Gaithersburg. Another old house, part log, was on Welsh Road at the sewage treatment plant on Magruder Branch. This was the old Ed Thompson place. (Note: this was probably the old Boylston farm, demolished ca. 1973 (without my knowledge) on M-NCPPC or WSSC property. Mr. J.E. Duvall of Rte. 124 knew area's history-died last year or so at age of 103.)
