DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The house is a two story, frame structure with a three bay, central entrance, main (west) facade. There is a central gable with a lunette window. The chimneys are internal at either gable end. To the east is a two story el. The main block is divided into two rooms separated by the central stair hall. The el is also two rooms, divided by a central chimney.

South of the house is a bankbarn with a stone foundation and frame structure. The framing is sawn, with the roof supported by trusses, joined with mortised, tenoned, and pegged joints.
