<p style="margin-left: 40px;">The house is a 1-1/2 story building, the west end of which is stone, and the east end frame. There is a brick chimney stack that was originally the internal end chimney for the stone section.</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">The original main facade (now the rear facade) is two bays with the entrance through the west bay. The stone section has one dormer on each facade, as does the frame section. The present entrance is through the center bay of the three bay frame addition.</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">The cornice is boxed. Heavy stone lintels support the walls.</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">Mr. Daniels, who lives in the modern red brick rambler to the east of the miller's house, says the mill ruins were destroyed when his family owned the house in the late 1920's.</p>
