This was a turn-of-the-century frame cross-gable with an older rear wing. The wing faced west towards Damascus, and was three bays wide with 6/6 sash windows. A shed-roofed porch on square posts, one bay of which was enclosed, faced west. The newer front section of the house faced north, with 2/2 sash windows, return cornices, and a cross gable. It was also three bays wide, and had a shed-roofed front porch on square posts. Corbeled brick stove chimney stacks rose from within each gable end, and another brick stove chimney stood at the junction of the newer main block and the rear wing. The roof of both parts of the house was of standing seam metal.

Outbuildings on the property included a frame barn with exposed rafter feet, and a stone dairy dated 1885, with a shingle roof.

Mr. Bowman's grandfather was Rezin Bowman, who lived southwest of here. His father moved to this place in 1878 and erected the present buildings. McKendree "Macky" Bowman was a bachelor, who ran the farm by himself for years. The farm buildings are no longer standing. The site where they once stood is now the entrance to the Bowman Acres development.

This latter section is oriented to the north, and there are three bays and a center gable on this facade (windows here are 2/2.) There are one-story, shed-roof porches on both sections. Nearby is a stone dairy with a shingle roof that is dated 1885.</p>


