

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a two-story, frame farmhouse typical of the area but with several added touches. It is of 3 bays on the main (north) facade and there is a peaked center gable here. Unlike many such houses, this one has a fine molded cornice that "breaks" at the center gable and the gable itself is covered with patterned shingles and has a diamond-shaped window in the center. Another unusual feature is the placement of two, central stove chimneys in the center of the roof ridge (most houses have end chimneys.)

There is a large frame bank barn nearby.
