Prepare both a summary paragraph of significance and a general statement of history and support.

The Richard Kinnard house is significant as an example of vernacular architecture typical of that constructed in Montgomery County from the mid-nineteenth through the early twentieth centuries. The house is believed to have been built by William Kinnard (no Richard appears in the deeds etc. associated with the house) between 1841 and 1858.¹ William bought the land on which the house rests, 136 3/4 acres of "Snowden's Second Addition to His Manor",² in 1841 for \$600 from Joshau Gilpin, trustee for Bernard Gilpin.

In August of 1876, William and his wife conveyed 20 acres and 14 perches of their land to Annie T. Porter who had loaned William mortgage money in 1867.³ Due to William's indebtedness to Porter, Annie had acquired William's entire estate by 1887.⁴ When Annie died in 1906 the farm was passed on to Oscar and Sarah Leizear as directed by Annie's will.⁵ The Leizears owned the house until January of 1943 when they sold it to Henry and Ellen Kunnold, the present owners. The house then sat on 16.09 acres of land.⁶
