DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The house is an L shaped Victorian frame farmhouse, 2 1/2 stories tall and five bays wide. The one story bay windows on the north and south ends sit on integral foundations with the main house block, indicating they are contemporary with its construction. This block is covered with shiplap siding. The rear wing is covered with flush siding.

The main (west) facade has five bays; the porch has been removed. The two windows flanking the door extend to the porch floor. The entrance with transom and side lights, is heavily moulded in an Italianate manner. Door and window surrounds heavy roll mouldings.

Along the south side of the rear wing is a two story gallery porch with square chambered posts.

The foundation is stone under the main block and brick on the rear wing.

The bankard behind the house is about seventy years old; it is supposed to be the last barn in Montgomery County raised by hand.
