The Cromwell House is a mid-nineteenth century frame I house that has lost its integrity. Abandoned for a least twenty years, the two story dwelling has experienced significant deterioration and loss of materials. No windows, doors or interior trim remain and considerable portions of the clapboard have been removed. The standing seam metal gable roof does remain. The setting has been lost to overgrown trees and vegetation. A barn no longer exists. The property does not retain sufficient integrity to be eligible for the National Register.


