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The old farmhouse here probably dates from about 1900. It is a two-story, frame, L-shaped structure, with a three-bay west facade on the main section. Siding is of asbestos shingles, and there are thin, stove-type chimneys in each section.

The log smokehouse is either a late example of a much older style, or it remains from an earlier farm complex (probably the former.) The logs are exposed, and they were hewn and notched by hand. The chinking is also done in the old manner, but much of the old mortar has been covered with modern cement. The roof overhangs the (east) door by a foot or two, and it is covered with newer wood shingles.


ACTION TAKEN
