DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This was the site of the J.E. Buck farm in 1878. However, the present buildings appear to date from the early 20th Cen. The house is a square, classical-revival farmhouse.

The most notable farm building is a large hay barn, built into a shallow bank. There are three, evenly-spaced, cupola-type vents along the ridge of its roof.




