DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The lock house is a story and a half, stone building with a large central chimney and a small chimney on the east end. The five bay facade has two doorways--one in the west bay and one in the second bay from the east end. Lintels are stone. On the rear facade there is a single dormer.

The building appears to have been built in two sections or for two separate uses. The east end forms a three bay unit with a central doorway and the west end is a two bay unit with an end doorway.

The lock is cut Seneca sandstone.
