<p>This is a small, two-bay, log cabin with a loft above. The main (south) facade consists of a door in the west-end bay and one 6/6 window. The west-end wall is blank, except for an attic window. A brick chimney stack exits from the east-end wall, and it appears to have an old fireplace base—that is now obscured by a small, shed-roof addition here. The roof is steeply-pitched, and covered with tin sheets. The rest of the house is covered with asphalt shingle siding.</p> <p>House can best be seen from N.W. Golf Course to the west. Sits above creek.</p>

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This house presently belongs to nearby "Pleasant View" Farm, but it appears from old maps that it was probably a slave or tenant house for the Bready farm, "Montmorency" (now N.W. Branch Golf Course.) Despite its poor appearance and condition, this house may be one of the oldest slave/tenant houses still standing in the area. Needs further evaluation. Owner does not feel it is worth saving.
