Prepare both a summary paragraph and a general description of the resource and its various elements as it exists today.

The Solomon Hansborough Property is a 1½-story, 3-bay cottage with bungalow features on the south side of Good Hope Road in the Cloverly vicinity, Montgomery County. Constructed in 1932, the building has 3/4-width shed roof dormers with exposed rafters on both the front and rear elevations and a full-width porch on the front elevation. A full-width rear porch has been enclosed.

The structure has a side-gable, asphalt shingle roof with a central brick chimney. It is of wood-frame construction with asbestos shingle siding and it has a concrete foundation. The windows are wood frame. The porch on the front elevation has tapered, square wood columns, a wood railing and a wood floor. A new wood ramp now extends from the porch floor to the driveway to the north of the structure.

The front, or north facade has an entrance in the first bay of the first floor, with a wood door with 6-lights. There is a paired, 6/1 double-hung window on the first story and three, 6/1 double-hung windows in the shed roof dormer.

The east elevation has a wood door at grade and two, 2-light sliding windows on the basement level. There are two windows on the first story; the first is a 6/1 double-hung window, while the second is a smaller, 6/1 double-hung window. There is one, 6/1 double-hung window in the gable end. The east elevation of the enclosed rear porch has paired 6/6 double-hung windows.

The first story of the rear, or south elevation is covered by the enclosed rear porch. The porch has an entry with an aluminum storm door, two, paired 6/6 double-hung windows, one, 6/6 single double-hung window, and a fixed, 6-light window. The shed roof dormer has three, 6/1 double-hung windows.

The west elevation has two, 2-light sliding windows on the basement level. On the first story, there is one, 6/1 double-hung window, and a paired, 6/1 double-hung window. Two, 6/1 double-hung windows are located in the gable end.

Typical elements of a cottage with bungalow features, including shed roof dormers, exposed rafters, and front and rear porches are evident in this structure.

There is one outbuilding associated with this property. The structure is a wood-frame garage with a dual pitch, asphalt shingle roof, and wood clapboard siding. Constructed circa 1932, the structure has wood, sliding, double-doors on the east elevation and is located south of the house.

The property is located on the south side of Good Hope Road, with residential properties to the east, west, and south. A semi-circular driveway is located at the front of the structure, which extends to the rear of the property and the garage.

frame cottages were developed in the early to mid-twentieth century. Front gable and hipped roof cottages are primarily one to one-and-a-half-stories tall, 3 bays wide and several rooms deep. Side-gable and cross-gable structures are usually two to two-and-a-half-stories tall, are typically two to three bays in width and vary from one to three rooms deep. They usually include a porch covered with a shed roof. Porches are supported by posts often containing machine-produced Victorian ornamentation. Some cottages feature ornamentation drawn from Craftsman style or Colonial Revival architecture (Gottfried and Jennings 1988, viii-xv).

NATIONAL REGISTER EVALUATION:

The Solomon Hansborough Property, an example of a cottage with Bungalow features constructed in 1932, is not eligible for the National Register of Historic Places. The property is not eligible under Criterion A, as research conducted indicates no association with any historic events or trends significant in the development of national, state or local history. Historic research indicates that the property has no association with persons who have made specific contributions to history, and therefore, it does not meet Criterion B. The property does not meet Criterion C, as it is an undistinguished example of a common building type during the early twentieth century, and does not exhibit any features or details of particular distinction. The property has no known potential to yield important information, and therefore, is not eligible under Criterion D.


