The Peach Cemetery was previously surveyed by the Maryland National Capital Park and Planning Commission in 1974. The cemetery is no longer extant, as a modern subdivision known as Oakberry has been constructed on the site. Construction of the subdivision involved extensive earth-moving.


National Register Evaluation:

The site of the Peach Cemetery is not eligible for the National Register of Historic Places. The property is not eligible under Criterion A, as research conducted indicates no association with any historic events or trends significant in the development of national, state or local history. Historic research indicates that the property has no association with persons who have made specific contributions to history, and therefore it does not meet Criterion B. The property is not eligible under Criterion C, as the cemetery is no longer extant and the site does not retain sufficient integrity to convey a distinctive design.






