DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The building is a stuccoed structure with a central block and flanking pavillions connected by galleries. The main block is two stories, with a classical revival facade; pilasters support a broad cornice below the forward-facing pediment. The one story pavillions are hip-roofed and have five large windows on the forward facade. The galleries also have large windows in two groups of five, so that each gallery clearly reads as two classrooms.

The building is a good example of early twentieth century school design with the different functional areas clearly revealed on the facade, generous multi-paneled windows, and a central block designed to express the idea of a public building.




