<p>The house is a two story, frame structure with a central doorway. The door has transom and sidelights. The flanking windows are double, 2/2 double hung sash. There is a central gable with a window on the main facade. Across the front is a five bay porch, the roof of which repeats the facade gable motif over the central bay. The cornice is returned into the gable ends. Across the rear facade is a two story gallery.</p> <p>The present siding is aluminum.</p> <p>In plan, the house has a central hall and flanking parlors.</p> <p>To the west is a lower, two story, two bay wing.</p> <p>A meat house stands to the east of the house.</p>

NORBOURNE - home of Richmond Irving Bowie

After completing school at Charlotte Hall Military Academy, (Charlotte Hall, Md.) R. Irving Bowie married Mary Ella Beall in 1880 and established a business in Georgetown. Finding this un congenial, his father situated him in the country on a farm of nearly 500 A. which he named Norbourne. Bowie's first wife died in 1889, leaving three sons.

In 1894, Bowie married Effie Gwynn of Sparten^aburg, S.C. He and his second wife continued to live at Norbourne and their eight children were born at this dwelling place.

Bowie served as a judge of the Orphans Court of PG County, for twenty years, during many of these yrs. he was chief judge. He died on December 16, 1923.


