Building #1990 is a 21' by 35' one-story tall brick structure located on the west side of the base. Although its original use is unknown, the building form and its location along Allentown Road suggest that it was either a commercial or institutional structure.

The building is three bays wide on the west side, with a centered Colonial Revival style panel door and equal, six-over-six double-hung wood windows. The opposite side of the structure has a single paneled door and six-over-six window. The south end of the building has two six-over-six windows, one each side of a brick chimney. The north end has a large, floor-to-ceiling opening that has been boarded up with plywood. This suggests that the building extended north with a secondary addition. The gabled roof is covered with a composition shingle.

Modifications to the building include the removal of the extension to the north, the addition of a brick interior wall dividing the single room, the removal of the chimney and floor on the building interior, and the installation of a hardened concrete floor and dropped fiberboard ceiling.

The original building setting along Allentown Road has been changed significantly with the introduction of strip development and the removal of all buildings and landscaping along the road adjacent to the structure. In addition, a portion of the north side of the building has been demolished, and modification have been made to its interior that diminish its historic integrity.



