STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This was undoubtedly the northernmost mill to have operated on Piscataway Creek. A mill was located here at least since the mid-19th Century, and was owned during that period by a Mr. Marshall-who lived in an old house still standing nearby. Possibly was part of the "Woodyard" or "His Lordship's Kindness" plantations originally.











