There are two separate sections joined together here. The main barn is a small building of hewn frame construction, covered with rough, old weatherboards and an old, wood-shingle roof. A low doorway is on the north side of the building. Added onto the west end of this part is a smaller, slightly-lower barn, with most of its siding removed. The main timbers are hewn, and mortised and tenoned. The roof here is also of old wood shingles.

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


