The ~~Alonza~~ crossroads of Tulls Corner was an active intersection during the second half of the nineteenth century when the rural, agricultural economy thrived with the production of grains and small fruits. Tulls Corner, located a mile south of Marion, was dominated by Tull family holdings that had been maintained since the eighteenth century. Born in 1854, Alonza is credited with the construction of this slightly unconventional farmhouse with clipped gable ends, a projecting front bay, and a decorative front porch. Adding interest to the yard are brick piers topped by ball finials.
