26 East Antietam Street is 2 storey (plus attic) brick house with a two storey wing on the rear. A three bay early 19th century urban dwelling, the first floor has been altered; the mullions have been changed on the second storey windows and there is a post Civil War bracket cornice. There are double chimneys within the end walls.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE (Include Personages, Dates, Events, Etc.)

26 East Antietam Street has suffered some normal alterations on the ground floor (usual when a basically domestic type of structure is converted for commercial use), but otherwise this house appears to be an early 19th century building [note double end chimneys, its long rearward stretching plan, roof slope, fenestration, etc.] and a fairly good example of a type once common in Hagerstown, for example, 141 South Potomac Street and 66-68 West Washington Street.
