DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Although the ground floor of this building has been altered, the upper storeys of the Junior No. 3 firehouse exhibit some fine constructional details, marking this as a fairly good [stylistically] Victorian commercial structure. Most notable is the central tower with its belfry mounted on top of a mansard roof. This tower breaks the main bracketed cornice, above which there is the main roof, also mansard. Roofs are covered with polychromed, banded shingles. The two main second storey windows are set within large Romanesque arches.
