**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

The Home Federal Building stands at 120-130 West Washington Street in Hagerstown, Washington County, and is located on the north side of the street in the eastern quarter of the block formed by Summit Avenue and Prospect Street, the second block west of public Square.

The building is a 1965, three story, masonry and metal commercial structure which includes an earlier building (believed to date from the nineteenth century). Free-standing, the building sits in row with other structures and has only narrow passages along the sides. The facade or south elevation is covered with panels of small stones and has a recessed first story with large display windows. The upper levels have three strips of windows, one on each floor.


