
Property Name/Address: Hagerstown Equipment Company, Maryland Ave. and Memorial Blvd., Hagerstown, Maryland

Description/Significance: A turn of the twentieth century manufacturing complex, comprising several large multistoried gable-roofed brick buildings, reflecting the industrial development of the area during the period. The principal structures include a two-story gable-front building, five bays wide by 14 bays deep, and a three-story structure, 13 bays wide by four bays deep. Both buildings are constructed of brick and have broad, low-pitched gable roofs; multipaned windows (typically 12/12 or 8/8) are located in segmental-arched openings.
