
Property Name/Address: Homestead Apartment Building, 25-27 East Washington St.,
Hagerstown, Maryland

Description/Significance: Remodeled in 1899 and 1940, this three-story, four-bay building includes what appears to be an early (pre-1780) stone two story dwelling as the initial part of its construction. An oriel above the entrance survives from the 1899 remodeling, and the 1940 renovation is represented by a modern storefront faced with Carrara glass.
