Description:

Apparently built as a furniture warehouse along the Washington County Branch of the B&O Railroad, this two story structure is of rock-faced concrete block, sometimes referred to as patent stone or artificial stone. It is a gable roofed building with bays divided along the sides by vertical pilasters. A loading dock, presumably for rail cars is located at the southwest corner of the building.

Significance:

This building is one of several commercial/industrial buildings constructed along the railroads in Hagerstown. A small and unpretentious structure, it reflects the lesser role of the B&O Railroad among the rail lines coming into Hagerstown. Most of the larger industries that chose to build along the rail lines located along the Western Maryland and Cumberland Valley Railroads.


