| DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE | | |
| <p>This house is located west of White Hall Road about one mile south of Chewsville in Washington County, Md. It is situated on an area of level ground and faces east.</p> <p>The structure is a two-story, three-bay dwelling, possibly of stone construction, covered with stucco. An addition of coved board siding extends to the rear or west of the main section.</p> <p>The windows appear to have been spaced evenly in the front elevation. They are small in size and contain two-over-two pane Victorian period sashes. Louvered shutters flank the openings at the front elevation. A single window at each story is centered in the gable walls.</p> <p>The main entrance is located in the center bay of the front elevation. It is quite simple in appearance and includes a narrow four-light transom. A modern hipped roof entrance porch is present at the front elevation.</p> <p>The roof is covered with sheet metal and terminates with a barge board set directly against the end walls. The eaves are finished with plain boxing. A small brick chimney is located inside the north end wall.</p> <p>Just east of the house is a stone outbuilding partially covered with roughcast or stucco. It may have been used as a summer kitchen. Further east of the house is a large stone bank barn with an illegible date stone set in its east gable end.</p> <p>The buildings are in good condition and stand on a tract containing 113.66 acres.</p> | | |

| STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE <p style="margin-left: 40px;">The area of significance of this house is its architecture. Although its wall construction has been concealed by the stucco coating, the house as well as the barn would appear to date from the first half of the 19th century. The structures reflect vernacular building traditions in stone prevalent in Washington County.</p> | | | |


