DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house is located on the east side of Clopper Road about 3/4 mile north of Old Forge Road in Washington County, Maryland. It is situated on rather high, level ground east of the Antietam Creek and faces south.

The structure is a two story, three bay brick dwelling set on roughly coursed fieldstone foundations. Attached to the west end of the brick structure is a one and a half story, three bay stone section, constructed of rubble fieldstone with some evidence of coursing at the front elevation.

The walls of the brick structure display Flemish bonding at the front elevation, while common bond is evident in the other walls. Flat arches, one brick in height are present over openings in the front and side elevations and those at the first story level of the rear wall. The stone section shows no decorative masonry except for a segmented stone arch near ground level of its west elevation at the head of an opening which has since been enclosed. A very primitive keystone arrangement is present over the window at the front elevation of the stone section.

Windows appear to be spaced rather evenly in the structure. All have six over six pane double hung sashes held within narrow frames finished with a beaded edge.

The main entrance is located in the center bay of the front elevation of the brick section. The entrance way is framed similarly to the windows with a transom divided by crossed muntins. An unusual eight paneled door is flanked by matching paneled jambs. Other entrances, with similar framing are present in the front and rear elevations of the stone section.

The roof of each section is covered with sheet metal terminating with beaded barge boards set directly against the end walls. Simple boxing finishes the eaves. Brick chimneys are located inside each gable end.

The house is in fair condition and is located on a tract containing 87.96 acres. Near the house is a modern barn and other buildings related to agricultural use.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The area of significance of this house is its architecture. Constructed of two native materials and possibly during two periods, the house is representative of Washington County's vernacular architecture. The exterior wood at both sections appears consistent and is of a type used during the mid-nineteenth century in Washington County.


