DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE	
<p>This house is located on the west side of Charles Mill Road, about one and a half miles south of its junction with the Leitersburg-Ringgold Road, Maryland Route 418 in Washington County. It is situated on gently sloping ground and faces east.</p> <p>The structure is a two story, three bay weather boarded dwelling which appears to be of log construction.</p> <p>Openings are spaced in the walls with some concern for symmetry. Windows, having modern single pane double hung sashes appear small in relation to wall area. Most windows are flanked with pairs of louvered shutters.</p> <p>The main entrance is in the north bay of the front or east elevation. Its treatment is simple with a narrow transom topping the door. Another entrance is located in the north elevation.</p> <p>The roof is covered with sheet metal and extends beyond the end walls. The eaves and barge board are finished with simple molding. The chimneys display somewhat unusual placement, one being located inside the south gable end and west of the roof peak; the second, an interior chimney is situated toward the north end of the house east of the roof peak.</p> <p>One story porches extend along the front and north elevations.</p> <p>A large barn and other buildings related to agricultural use are located south of the dwelling.</p> <p>The house appears to be in fair to good condition and is located on a tract containing 79 acres.</p>

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE			
<p>The area of significance of this house is its architecture. Although the house has been covered with weatherboarding, it would appear to be of log construction. Log structures form a major architectural group in Washington County, where log was used extensively as a building material from the earliest days of settlement until late in the 19th century. Many of these structures remain in use today, concealed by various forms of siding or bricks. It would appear that his house was sheathed during the late 19th century.</p> <p>According to Herbert C. Bell's <u>History Of Leitersburg District</u>, this house was built by John Stoner who died in 1806.⁽¹⁾ The property on which the house stands was purchased by John Stoner, (Liber 0, Folio 78) from his brother-in-law, John Barr in 1801, (Liber 103, Folio 410). It remained in the Stoner family until 1895. The tract is part of the land grant, "Resurvey On Deceit," which was purchased by Martin Barr, father of John Barr in 1783.</p>


