DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This property is said to have been the site of the former Wolf's Carpet Factory which was in operation here during the late 19th century. The tract lies between Mt. Tabor Road and Spade Road near the Conococheague Creek west of Hagerstown in Washington County, Maryland.

The only old building remaining on the property is a log and frame dwelling which has been altered extensively. It is a one and a half story structure which stands on a slope above Rush Run, a tributary of the Conococheague Creek. The house, the front section of which is of log construction faces east. A frame addition extends to the rear. The entire building has been sheathed with composition siding. The tract contains 3.78 acres.


