DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This small log and frame house is located on the south side of West Washington Street near its junction with McDade Road west of Hagerstown in Washington County, Maryland. It is situated near the edge of the road below its grade level. The house is a one story, three bay frame dwelling with a one story, three bay log wing sheathed with stucco or rough cast. Part of the front elevation is covered with aluminum siding and is said to have been rebuilt.

Windows have six over six pane double hung sashes held within narrow casings. The main entrance is located in the east end bay of the front or north elevation. A transom is included above the door. Another door is located in the east elevation of the wing. At that elevation the roof overhangs several feet beyond the wall.

The roof is sheathed with asphalt shingles. The front section has an inside end chimney at its east wall and a small exterior flue at its west end. The back or log part has a large exterior chimney. A gable roofed dormer window protrudes from the north slope of the roof.

The house appears to be in fair to good condition and stands on a lot 100 X 240 feet.




