DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house was located east of Hopewell Road and north of Halfway Blvd. southwest of Hagerstown in Washington County, Maryland. Since it was surveyed in 1975, the house has been torn down.

It was a two story L-shaped brick structure resting on fieldstone foundations. The main section of the house faced east with the principal entrance being in its east end wall. The wing extending in a southerly direction from this main part appeared to be partially constructed of new bricks laid in all stretcher bond on old stone foundations. The main section utilized common bonding at all elevations. Windows had two over two pane double hung sashes held within narrow frames beneath wide wooden lintels.

At the time it was photographed the house appeared to be in excellent condition. Nearby was a small bank barn. The property contains 4.82 acres.


