DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This farm is located east of Maryland Route 63, south of Huyetts Crossroads west of Hagerstown in Washington County. The buildings are situated on relatively level ground with the house facing south and the barn east.

The house is a two story, six bay structure which appears to be of frame construction, sheathed with aluminum siding. Projecting from the roof west of the center is a triangular dormer. The three eastern bays are recessed beneath a two story porch under the main roof span.

Windows and doors appear to be aligned with each other in the walls but are not arranged symmetrically. Windows have six over six pane sashes held within narrow casings and are flanked with pairs of louvered shutters. The window in the projecting gable is of the palladian style with an arched opening flanked by two rectangular windows. Doors are located in the second bay from the west end of the house and at the east end bay. Both are plain and do not include transoms.

The roof is sheathed with asphalt shingles and extends beyond the end walls of the house. Brick chimneys with several courses of corbeling at their tops are located inside the end walls. A large chimney extends from the house at the front where the recess in the walls begins.

A one story porch with a low hipped roof supported by doric type pillars extends along part of the front elevation.

East and southeast of the house are outbuildings, a stone smokehouse with a steeply pitched hipped roof and a frame summer kitchen. South of the house is a frame bank barn on stone foundations. In its end walls it has louvered ventilators with Victorian trim. Decorated metal ventilators extend from the roof peak.

The buildings are in excellent condition and stand on a tract containing almost 124 acres.



