DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This farm complex is located at the end of a private lane which extends in an easterly direction from Garis Shop Road south of Funkstown, west of the Antietam Creek in Washington County, Maryland. The house is situated on relatively level high ground and faces south. The barn faces east.

The house is a two story, four bay building believed to be of log construction and completely sheathed with aluminum siding. A two bay, two story frame wing extends to the rear or north. Log construction is suggested for the front of the house by the thickness of the door and window jambs.

First story windows at the front of the house have modern single pane sashes. Above them are windows with two over two pane sashes. Some six over six pane sashes remain in the windows of the wing.

The main entrance is located in the second bay from the east end of the front or south elevation. The original door has been replaced. The house has a standing seam sheet metal roof which extends beyond the end walls. A modern concrete block flue stands against the south end wall, but a patch in the roof suggests that another chimney may have been located inside the north end wall.

West of the house is a large frame bank barn resting on fieldstone foundations. The farm contains 175 acres.


