DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house is located at the end of Beckley Avenue behind the Valley Mall Shopping Center in Halfway, Washington County, Maryland. It is situated on an area of level ground and faces southwest.

It is a two story, five bay building, presumably of log construction and sheathed with wooden siding. One story porches, partially enclosed are attached to each end wall. A two story two bay ell extends to the rear while an addition, perhaps an enclosed two story porch, is located along the rear wall of the main section.

Windows are aligned with each other in the walls but appear to be offset slightly toward the west corner of the house. Nine over six windows are present at the first story level while six over six windows are used elsewhere.

The main entrance is located in the center bay of the front elevation. It is trimmed with a modern Georgian style broken pediment. A 19th century six panel door is used.

The house is roofed with asphalt shingles. Small brick chimneys are located inside the walls. A third chimney, also of brick is located at the exterior of the ell.

Although much altered, the house appears to be in excellent condition. It stands on a tract containing 83.68 acres. Near the house are several stone fences and foundations of a barn.


