Description:

Located at the southeast corner of what was originally designated to be the town square, this house is a two story, five bay sided log building with a 1½ story wing to the rear. It has a symmetrically arranged front with a central entrance and appears to date from the early 19th century. Windows have nine over six light sash at both the first and second story levels. The roofing material is standing seam sheet metal. Chimneys are located inside the end walls. The siding with the over-sized bottom bead probably dates from the ca. 1900 period and replaced original siding.

Lot 84 on which this house is situated was one of four at the intersection of Baltimore and High Streets which had portions of their fronts reserved by the Town for use as a town square. The house is set on high ground back from the street.




