Located on the west side of West Side Avenue at Maple Street, is this small log house, a three bay, one and a half story structure. It has been covered with aluminum siding. A shed dormer and an overhanging front porch have been added, giving the house the appearance of a bungalow. The changes to the exterior of this house make an estimate of age difficult.

It is shown on the 1877 Atlas map of Funkstown as part of the property of the Funkstown Manufacturing Company.


