Description:

Located on lot #156 of Funkstown's original plat and opposite the cemetery's oldest section is this early 20th century American Foursquare style house. It is a three bay wide frame structure covered with aluminum siding. It has the typical hipped roof with hip roofed dormers, and a porch across the front. The windows have single pane sash and the entrance is located in the center bay of the front elevation.

On this lot was built the original Lutheran and German Reformed Church, in 1771. It was a log structure. Later, a log school was attached to its north side. The church was constructed in close proximity to the town cemetery. The Lutherans built a brick church on E. Baltimore Street in 1850, replacing the old log structure.


