Description:

This two story, three bay L-shaped brick house is located on the south side of Green Street. The bricks forming the walls are laid in common bond. All second story openings are topped with segmental arches of brick. First story openings have splayed jack arches. Windows have nine over six light sash, characteristic of the early 19th century. The main entrance is located in the center bay of the front elevation and includes a narrow transom. A two story wing to the rear has a double porch along the east side. The use of nine over six windows and the change in the type of brickwork at openings between the first and second stories suggests that this may be in part an older house, perhaps a one story log building enlarged to two stories and encased with brick.

The 1877 Atlas map shows a house at this location belonging to Mrs. Andrews.




