Description:

This house is located at the southwest corner of Green Street and West Side Avenue and along the Antietam Creek. It is a two story, four bay German sided log house, with two central front entrances. Windows have single pane sash, replacements of the originals. The two entrances are sheltered by a shed roofed porch. There is a one story kitchen extension to the rear. A modern garage is located west of the house. Exterior finishes on this house date from the late 19th century or later. Its true age may be much older, but an accurate assessment can not be made from casual observation.

A house is shown on this property in the 1877 Atlas map of Funkstown. It belonged to W. Bowman.


