Description:

This small log house is located on the south side of Cemetery Street. It is a one story, three bay structure covered with wooden siding which probably dates from the 1950s.

Windows have single pane sash, replacements of the originals. The front door is in the central bay and has a lintel higher than those of the windows. A shed roofed porch extends across the three front bays. It is impossible to ascertain the age of this building from a brief examination of the exterior. It could be a quite early structure.

It is shown on the 1877 Atlas map of Funkstown and was owned at that time by W. Fisher.
