Description:

Probably constructed about 1890-1900 is this two story, three bay frame house covered with insul siding. Windows have two over two pane sash and the entrance is located in the central bay of the front elevation. A shed roofed porch supported by round columns extends across the front. There are shed extensions to the rear.

The 1877 Atlas map indicates that there was a house on this site at that time, owned by G. Kendall. This place represents some of the later buildings which are found in the outer areas of Funkstown.
