This is a two story, three bay American Foursquare style house of brick construction. It has Colonial Revival style features such as a pedimented entrance hood and Palladian window in the front dormer. Windows have single pane sash. The front entrance is in the center bay, creating a symmetrical facade. The house has the characteristic foursquare hipped roof.

Apparently there was an earlier house on this site as indicated in the 1877 Atlas map.


