DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This small log house is located on the west side of Snyders Landing Road overlooking the Potomac River northwest of Sharpsburg in Washington County, Maryland. It is situated on high ground and faces west.

The building is a two story, two bay structure built of log and sheathed with German siding. Very little of its original appearance is visible since windows have been replaced. The roof has been reshingled and a wide screened porch has been built across the front of the house.

It is in excellent condition. It stands below a large 18th century brick mansion, Mt. Pleasant which was the home of William Chapline, founder of Sharpsburg. Civil War uniform buttons and belt buckles were found when an adjoining property was excavated.


